AEROSPACE CYBER SENTRI ACCESS AND USE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The Aerospace Cyber System Explicit Normalized Threat Risk Insights ("Cyber SENTRI") is a spreadsheet based tool that includes embedded formulas to calculate scores representing a system's cyber risk posture. The tool does this by allowing the users to enter data on their system's vulnerabilities and with that data, Cyber SENTRI employs a series of formulas to calculate the custom/unique risk score of that system and displays the results in a series of tables within that spreadsheet.

Cyber SENTRI contains a large "Cyber Risk Register" of approximately 26,000+ "cyber risk scenarios." These cyber risk scenarios are derived using guidance from a MITRE organization called the Center for Threat Informed Defense (CTID), guidance in NIST SP 800-30R1 (entitled "Guide to Conducting Risk Assessments), and data from the MITRE Adversary Tactics & Techniques Common Knowledge (ATT&CK) framework.

The user of the Cyber SENTRI can enter their system's non-compliant Risk Management Framework (RMF) controls which Cyber SENTRI formulas then use to determine which of the 26,000+ risk scenarios are valid for the system and creates a series of charts and findings to educate the user as to the cyber risk level and cyber risk locations within their system.

Cyber SENTRI, and related material and documentation developed and owned by The Aerospace Corporation (hereinafter "Licensor" or "Aerospace"), a California nonprofit corporation, whose address is 2310 East El Segundo Boulevard, El Segundo, CA 90245. Cyber SENTRI is made available to the Space ISAC and its members (hereinafter collectively "Licensee") at no cost. Access to and use of Cyber SENTRI are subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. Aerospace hereby grants to Licensee a limited, nonexclusive, nontransferable, royalty-free license to access and use Cyber SENTRI and updates, improvements, modifications, or enhancements thereto as may be provided from time to time if any, solely for use in connection with Space ISAC purposes and objectives only and not for any commercial purposes. Any and all rights not expressly granted by this License are expressly reserved by Aerospace. Licensee is authorized to utilize any documentation as is reasonably necessary for Licensee's access and use of Cyber SENTRI.
- 2. Licensee agrees to provide reasonable feedback in written form to Aerospace including, but not limited to, installation and set-up process, usability, errors or bugs, and test results with respect to Cyber SENTRI testing and evaluation. Due to the nature of the development work, Aerospace provides no assurance that any specific errors or discrepancies in Cyber SENTRI will be corrected. All error and bug reports, test results, and other feedback provided to Aerospace by the Licensee may be used by Aerospace for any purpose.

- 3. Licensee Material. Any data, information, models and/or other content inputed or stored in Cyber SENTRI by Licensee (collectively "Licensee Material") shall remain Licensee Material. Licensee owns all intellectual property and other proprietary rights in and to the Licensee Material. Licensee hereby grants to Aerospace a worldwide, nonexclusive, fully-paid up and non-transferable license to use the Licensee Material to manage, maintain, perform and/or provide Cyber SENTRI, and to use Licensee Material in connection with supporting Space ISAC and the U.S. Government.
- 4. Cyber SENTRI may contain, include and/or stores Controlled Unclassified Information and Licensee shall apply reasonable and appropriate administrative, technical, physical, organizational, and operational safeguards and operations, including, but not limited to the Basic Safeguarding Controls set forth in FAR 52.204-21 to protect any Covered Defense Information (CDI) as defined in DFARS 252.204-7012 and Controlled Unclassified Information (CUI) as defined in the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) Registry against accidental and unlawful destruction, alteration, and unauthorized or improper disclosure or access. To the extent that the obligations of the Licensee hereunder require or involve creation, storage, transmittal or access to Covered Defense Information (CDI) as defined in DFARS 252.204-7012, Safeguarding Covered Defense Information and Cyber Incident Reporting, CDI shall be protected in accordance with DFARS 252.204-7012, the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) Special Publication (SP) 800-171 "Protecting Controlled Unclassified Information in Nonfederal Information Systems and Organizations," as well as any applicable U.S. Government laws, regulations, or policies.
- 5. Cyber SENTRI may contain, include and/or stores classified information and shall be handled in accordance with the Department of Defense National Industrial Security Program Operating Manual (DoD 5220.22-M), its Supplements, and other applicable U.S. Government security regulations and requirements.
- 6. Licensee shall not, without the prior written consent of Aerospace, which can be withheld in its absolute discretion: (i) use the name and trademarks of The Aerospace Corporation or any of its employees, or any adaptation thereof, in any publicity, advertising, press releases, marketing activities, annual reports, promotional or sales literature, or on any web site; and (ii) use The Aerospace Corporation or any of its employees as a reference in any manner whatsoever to promote Licensee's products and capabilities. Request for an approval shall be directed to Aerospace's Office of the General Counsel.

7. Term and Termination:

- a. Absent any breach of these terms and conditions, access and use of Cyber SENTRI afforded Licensee shall continue uninterrupted.
- b. In the event of a breach of any of these terms and conditions, Licensee acknowledges and agrees that Aerospace shall have no adequate remedy at law and shall thereafter be entitled to enforce any such provision by temporary or permanent injunctive or mandatory relief obtained in any court of competent jurisdiction without the necessity of proving damages, posting a bond or other security, and without prejudice to or diminution of any other rights or remedies which may be available.
- c. In the event of a breach of these terms and conditions, all rights granted to Licensee shall cease and Licensee's access and use of Cyber SENTRI shall be terminated.

- 8. These Terms and Conditions shall be interpreted and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of California (excluding its conflict of law principles) and any applicable Federal law. The Parties agree that the United Nations Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods (1980) is specifically excluded from and shall not apply to this Agreement.
- 9. Licensee shall comply with all applicable U.S. export control laws and regulations, including the requirements of the International Traffic in Arms Regulations ("ITAR") and the Export Administration Regulations ("EAR").

10. Technical Assistance and Improvements:

- a. Aerospace and its personnel cannot provide advisory service, technical support, or general assistance of any kind with respect to Cyber SENTRI.
- b. In no way is Aerospace obligated to: (1) perform, create, or provide any updates, improvements, modifications, or enhancements to Cyber SENTRI, (2) provide maintenance, installation, or training in relation to Cyber SENTRI, or (3) continue to provide Cyber SENTRI, Aerospace reserves the right to stop providing Cyber SENTRI at its sole discretion and at any time.

11. Intellectual Property Rights:

- a. Title to Cyber SENTRI shall at all times remain vested in Aerospace.
- b. 3rd Party Rights. Cyber SENTRI may currently or in the future include or incorporate 3rd party software, tools, data, information and/or capabilities including, but not limited to Open Source Software. Access and use of such 3rd party material shall at all-time be in compliance with the respective 3rd party license(s), including:

12. Warranty, Disclaimers and Limitation of Liability

- a. End Users and Licensees acknowledges that Cyber SENTRI: (i) is an engineering analysis tool only, and other tools or testing should be used to verify design and performance for any specific systems or applications; and (ii) was not designed or intended for use in or in connection with hazardous environments, including without limitation, in the operation of nuclear facilities, air traffic control, life-support systems, or other mission-critical applications and, therefore, Cyber SENTRI should not be relied upon for any systems or applications that involve life-critical decisions or the safety of human life, and national security. Cyber SENTRI is still under development and may contain errors or bugs.
- b. END USER AND LICENSEE AGREES THAT Cyber SENTRI IS PROVIDED "AS IS" AND ACKNOWLEDGES THAT NO WARRANTY(IES), EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, NONINFRINGEMENT, OR OTHERWISE IS MADE BY AEROSPACE. AEROSPACE DOES
